



## ANNUAL MAINTENANCE OF IN-GROUND POOL LIGHTING SYSTEM TO STORE AND CONSUMERS

To be able to enjoy your lights for as long as possible, we recommend that every year you follow the following in-ground pool light niches maintenance tips

Each time you close or open your pool, be sure to clean the bottom of the housing, where there are holes that allow water to drain out. To keep these niches clean, remove dirt, sand, leaves, rocks and any possible water build-up.



Note: Above are examples of boxes NOT cleaned and conditions of the lights.

Although the LED light is waterproof, it is not designed to soak in water. You must absolutely avoid any accumulation of water in the light niches.

If these holes are blocked by debris accumulation in the housings, water could reach the light and damage it, voiding the warranty and damaging the lighting system.

## **REQUIRED** TOOL:

Wet/Dry Vacuum Cleaner (like a 4HP or 6 HP Shop-Vac)



During the winter, remember to store the white or colored Lumi-DEL light in a dry and heated area if possible. For the conventional light, remove the bulb and store it inside. Cover the shell with a plastic bag and place it in the bottom of the box, opening down.

## TECHNICIAN'S VISIT

If a technician needs to come to your location to perform an installation or repair, he will not be able to perform the service for you if the cabinets are too dirty. To do the work he will have to reschedule an appointment and you may be charged an additional fee.
