




1) Remove the Innovaplas round cap from the step by compressing 2 tabs at the back. For the Biltmor or Aquarius step cut the 4 tabs with a utility knife to remove the blank cap.


2) Insert the lighting fixture from the outside of the step.

3) Fasten the treaded ring and align the fixture properly in the step before tightening. Tighten the ring moderately.

IMPORTANT: Use supplied tie wraps to attach electric cord to a post as shown. Do not submerge the connector the product could be damaged.

SECURING THE POWER CORD

1) Firmly attach the power cord to the rear posts using the 2 tie wraps provided. Attach the first tie wrap to no more than 2 inches from the bottom of the post.

2) Connect the waterproof connector. Do not submerge the cable connection.

3) Make sure the transformer is installed 10 feet away from the pool wall.

- Make sure the underwater portion of the power cord has been tied tightly to the step with the tie wraps to prevent any entanglement.
